



In fact about the only things John seemed to be interested in was bugging his sister when she had a date (he was six years younger than her) and playing sports with us older boys (he was five years younger than me) only because our parents said he had to play with me or I couldn't play, but we had to play by his rules or he would go home crying which would end the game.

As John got older he did enjoy swimming, fishing, speed and hunting which he still continues to this day. He also enjoys bow hunting for deer.

If you ask any of John's friends today they would tell you that if you needed help, John would be there to help you. I found this to be very true as John got older. I never asked for help from John without him jumping in and in most cases doing most of the work involved. Many times I would discuss a problem

with John and the next thing I would know he would be there with the solution.

After graduating from Richland High School, John started attending Western Michigan University in Kalamazoo, Michigan. After a semester he started working for the local A&P store and gave up the schooling. John was hired as a butcher trainee by the store.

After a short period of time he had a chance to work at Fuller Mfg. which paid much higher wages. John decided to work at Fuller Mfg. and spent about twenty years there working as a machinist and assembly line worker. After about twenty years, Fuller Mfg. (by this time it was known as Eaton ,Yale and Town with Fuller being a division) decided to shut down the plant in Kalamazoo since times were hard and they had other plants that could handle all the work that was done in Kalamazoo.

None of the union help was offered a job at the other plants since they were non-union. John eventually obtained a job at National Water Lift in Kalamazoo, Michigan. After about five years he was laid off by them and was never called back. The last I knew he was working odd jobs to survive.

John is quite handy with his hands and can do a number of things like welding, construction and bartending.

From the early years in junior high school until about his thirties, John liked to ride on and in things that moved fast. Starting with the boat I bought that was close to being a hydroplane (Grandma Lillie Penix Powers also liked to ride in the boat) to the car ('55 Chev) my father first sold to him after high school graduation where he replaced the six cylinder engine with a V8, to several

racing boats, to snow mobiles and lastly Wes

to motorcycles. He still has and uses a motorcycle (he says women love them).

John married **Judith Annette Hernacki** on August 29, 1964. Judith was born on July 5, 1942 in Detroit, Michigan. Her parents are Joseph Thomas Hernacki born on March 17, 1918 and died on October 18, 1980 and Lucille Agnes Kowalczewski born on October 21, 1918 and died on July 21, 1992.


worked at the rehab center and wants to obtain a job in a factory, but has had no offers to date.

Lisa also does some cake decorating and would like a new kitchen so she can become a baker full time. Lisa likes to sew, crochet and work out crossword puzzles.




