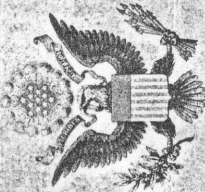

Best remembered that when residing at number 528 Railroad, John Konkula, who previous to his naturalization was a regular, term of the Common Pleas Court of Somerset County, held at Somerset, Penn., on the 14th day of November

in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and 28, the court having found that the petitioner intended to reside permanently in the United States and that he had in all respects complied with the Naturalization Laws of the United States, and that he was entitled to be so admitted, it was thereupon entered by the said court that he be admitted as a citizen of the United States of America.

In testimony whereof the seal of said court is hereunto affixed on the 14th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-eight of our Independence the one hundred and fifty-second.
