





The RailSplitters then went to the Christmas tournament at Southfield where the Parkers lost to Redford Union and Thurston but came back to defeat Monroe.



The Parkers came back with two well played victories over a defense minded Ypsilanti and an improved Melvindale team.







Joe Pilchak transferred his track ability to cross country very successfully. Joe worked up to the 4th. spot on the team through the determination which was shown by the whole team.








